

## **Dispatch Communications**



Washburn County Dispatch Center is the emergency and non-emergency call center for all of Washburn County. We dispatch law enforcement for municipal police departments in addition to the Sheriff's Office. Our Dispatch center also dispatches all emergency medical (EMS) and fire calls within our county.

Washburn County is 853 square miles and consists of 21 townships, two villages and two cities, with a population of approximately 15,928 people. The municipal police departments within our county are Spooner Police Department, Shell Lake Police Department, Birchwood Police Department and Minong Police Department. Washburn County Sheriff's Office has jurisdiction throughout the county and provides supplemental law enforcement within the municipalities.
