SRT

Washburn County SRT is a multi-jurisdictional response team that falls under the jurisdiction of the Sheriff's Office. SRT is tasked with responding to high-risk calls, barricaded subjects, search warrants, and search and rescue. All members of Washburn County SRT received specialized training and continue to receive monthly training. Opportunities include: less lethal, law enforcement marksmen, robot operator, and negotiators.
